A Place to Call Home

Independent Living provides up to 80 hours/month of one-on-one support to adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD) living in their own home. Services are focused on skills development. Supported Living assists adults with IDD to live independently or with paid support. We provide personalized one-on-one support designed to meet the individual needs of our clients.

ADDITIONAL SERVICES

Assessment & Intervention Services (AIS)

Our AIS program is designed to provide person-centered services and supports to individuals within the context of family homes, group homes and independent living arrangements. AIS staff, with input from the Interdisciplinary Planning Team, will provide youth, families, support staff and/or caregivers the tools necessary to help manage, reduce, and/or extinguish targeted behaviors.

Tailored Day Services (TDS)

Clients are encouraged to self-direct and participate in determining their program day. We are here to help our clients plan their day their way. With the anticipation of maximizing life satisfaction, this exciting program tailors our client's day based on their personal choices, hopes and dreams.

Paid Internship Program (PIP)

Designed to encourage competitive integrated employment; work for which an individual is paid minimum wage or greater in a setting with others who do not have disabilities. The goal of this program is for future paid employment.
